



it is located in the middle of the city centre.




The Louwman Museum

The [Louwman Museum](#) tells the story of over 130 years of progress, technical innovation and increasing prosperity. Over 275 icons from the history of the automobile play a central role. But there is more: impressive rooms with high ceilings, landscape gardens and the museum square in the style of the 1920s make the Louwman Museum the perfect location for your event.

The Conference Centre

The Postillion

Postillion Hotel & Convention Centre, The Hague's newest venue, serves the entire MICE market with a strong focus on association, governmental congresses and corporate events. With this unique full-service conference and event location, The Hague has gained an excellent location. They have the capacity for 1,400 pax on 4,000 m²

Good to know:

it is located next to the Hollands Spoor railway station with direct access to the major European cities, e.g. London, Paris and Brussels.



The Pier

This icon above the sea is the location for spectacular meetings and parties with 12,000 m² available and view over the beach and the North Sea. **De Pier** offers culinary enjoying at the foodboulevard, hotel staying in the Pier Suites, entering an extreme challenge in zipline or bungee jump, business meetings in the Sea View Offices, riding in the ferris wheel or drinking a beer at one of the outside terraces. Visiting De Pier with 2 people or a group of 3.000 guests, De Pier is the ideal location for your meeting, team building activity, dinner, presentation or business party.

The Madurodam

Who knew it was possible to see The Netherlands in 30 minutes? Yes, it's possible thanks to the interactive theme park [Madurodam](#) which brings together all of Holland's most interesting and recognisable sights.



The Hotels



The Hague Marriott

The Hague Marriott is situated just off the city centre, a stone's throw away from Scheveningen beach. The World Forum and Kunstmuseum are located right beside the hotel. You can host your company conference or business meeting here. The hotel offers 24 versatile indoor venue spaces including private garden/terrace, as well as expert planning and catering services.



The Carlton Ambassador

Carlton Ambassador is located near the World Forum and lies within walking distance of the Peace Palace and upscale shopping streets filled with boutiques, antique shops, art galleries, as well as a variety of attractive bars and restaurants. The hotel has 88 rooms and suites, each designed and furnished in its own unique design. In addition, there are two halls decorated in chic style, which can serve as beautiful backdrops for conferences, presentations, or festive gatherings.



Hilton The Hague

Hilton worldwide's first hotel in The Hague has 195 spacious rooms and is located in the Embassy Quarter and near the royal shopping district Noordeinde. The 11 meeting rooms have a total capacity of 400 persons.



The Leonardo Royal Hotel Den Haag Promenade

Leonardo Royal Hotel Den Haag Promenade is situated in between Scheveningen, the Embassy District and the city centre. The hotel has an in-house restaurant, bar and lounge: LEO's International Flavours and the Promenade Healthclub & Spa. With 10 conference rooms and located close to the World Forum, it is suitable for meetings and events.



The Indigo

Our final stop before bringing our city adventure to a close was for a farewell lunch at Hotel Indigo The Hague - Palace Noordeinde. Located in the middle of the centre, the former historic bank building opposite the Royal Palace and the office of the Dutch Royals.



The VOCO™

Based in the Royal Quarter, [voco The Hague](#), a beautiful former bank building, has the city's shops, museum and heritage locations as well as the embassies and Peace Palace within walking distance. By taking the tram in front of the hotel, you'll find yourself at the central railway station in 9 minutes or at the seaside within 15 minutes.

voco The Hague stands out with a distinct dining concept: Botanica offers an innovative plant-based menu in a striking kitchen, bar and lounge with a part-garden feel.



The Hotel Des Indes

[Hotel Des Indes](#) is a landmark in The Netherlands and is located directly at the historical Lange Voorhout in the city center of The Hague. It offers impressive salons for business as well as private functions in the beauty of natural daylight. The 92 spacious rooms and suites have its own characteristic ambiance, with historical aspects.



The Museums



The Mauritshuis

Our intimate, world-class museum is located in the heart of historical and political The Hague. The Mauritshuis not only houses a world-famous collection of 17th century art, but is also an inspiring work location.

At the Mauritshuis, they understand the art of togetherness. That's why they make their attractive rooms available for meetings, training courses, lectures, receptions and presentations. You are guaranteed to be inspired when surrounded by the very best paintings of our Dutch and Flemish masters.

The monumental city palace is located in the most beautiful area of The Hague, right in the historical centre, adjacent to the Binnenhof. You could not possibly offer your guests a more regal ambiance than this inspiring location with its prime collection of Dutch and Flemish paintings from the 17th century. From small groups to large gatherings (up to 350 guests), whether in combination with a visit to our special collection or otherwise.



The Museon-Omniversum

Looking for a unique location? Have you ever considered hosting your next meeting at a museum? In The Hague, you can! Our next stop was to visit Museon-Omniversum, the home of the Sustainable Development Goals in The Hague. During this interactive tour, we listened, learned and watched about the impact goals and the steps needed to help us all make a valuable contribution.



The Kunstmuseum

The Kunstmuseum Den Haag is a modern palace for the arts. Masterpieces of modern and contemporary art, fashion, and decorative arts belong to its collection. The permanent exhibitions include artworks by Mondrian, Picasso and Delftware. Next to that, the museum has around 30 temporary exhibitions each year. The museum is centrally located between The Hague city centre and Scheveningen. It is located near The Hague International Zone with organizations such as Europol, OPCW and Eurojust.



The Panorama

Panorama Mesdag offers a 360 degree vista of the sea, the dunes and the fishing village of Scheveningen as it was in 1881. We stepped back in time and experienced a unique view of our cultural heritage - the oldest 19th century panorama in the world on its original site. This venue can host a maximum of 150 persons including 10 meeting rooms.




The Event Design Collective
