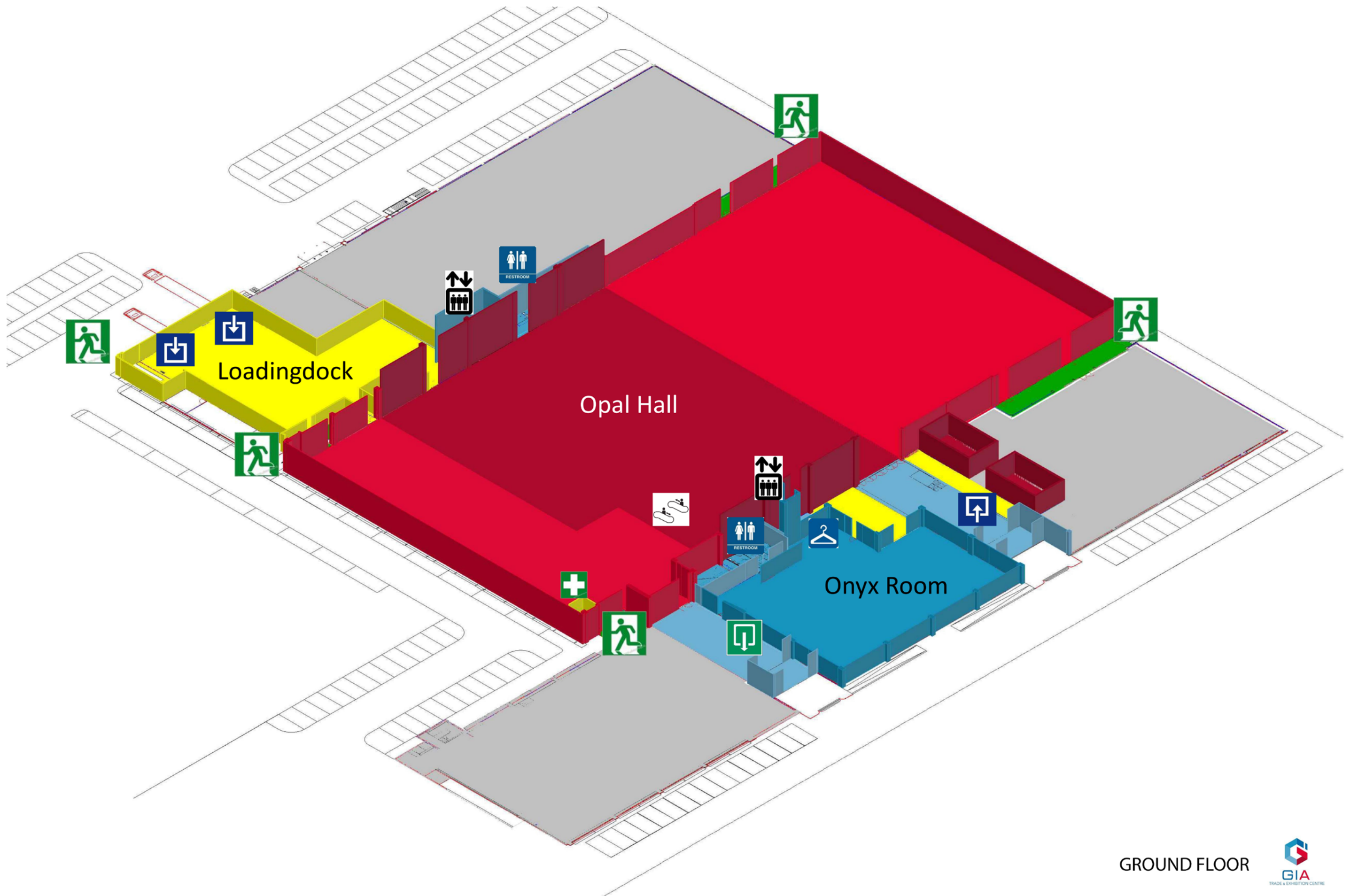
Top level business events

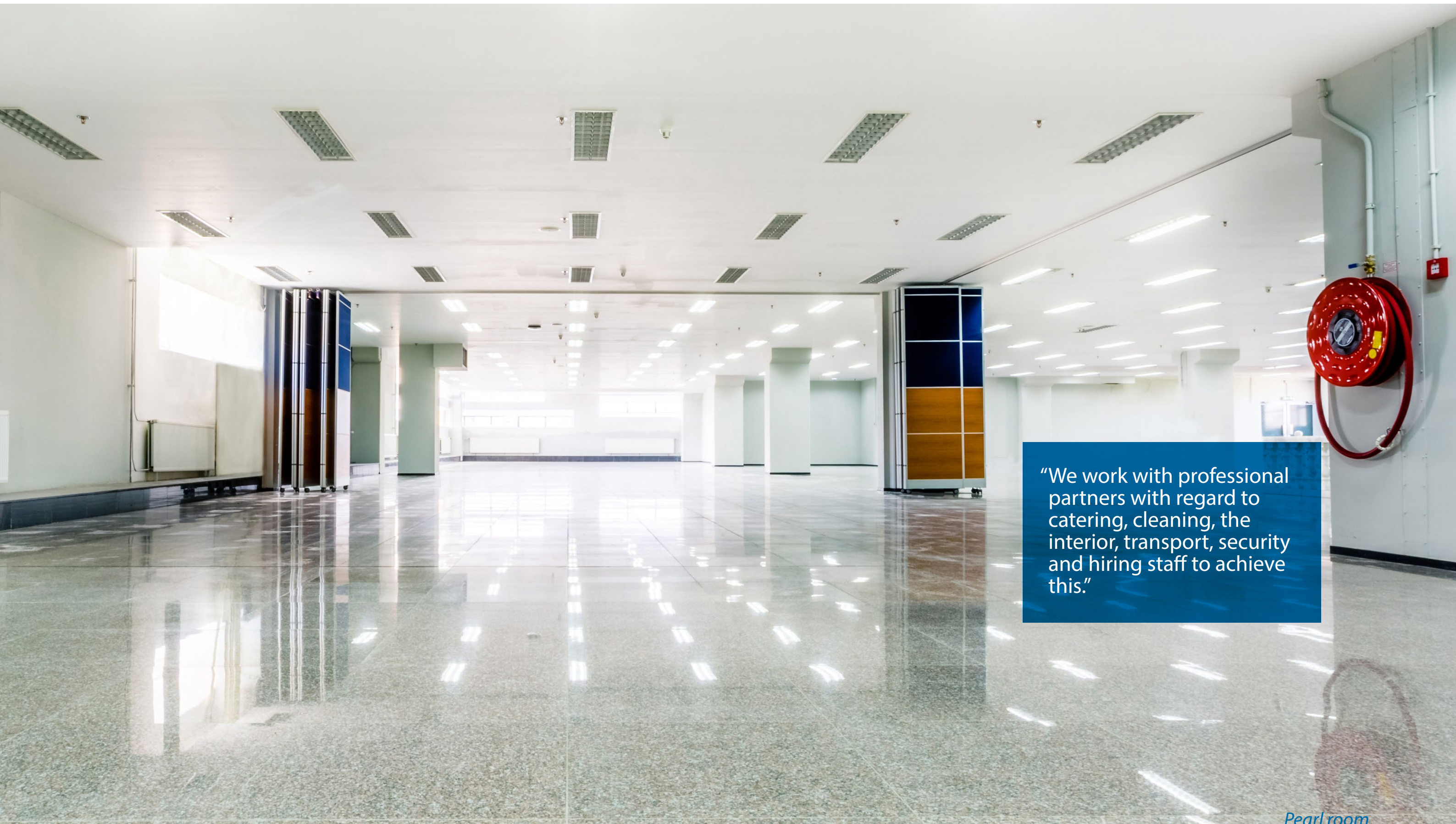


Opal hall

Multifunctional rooms

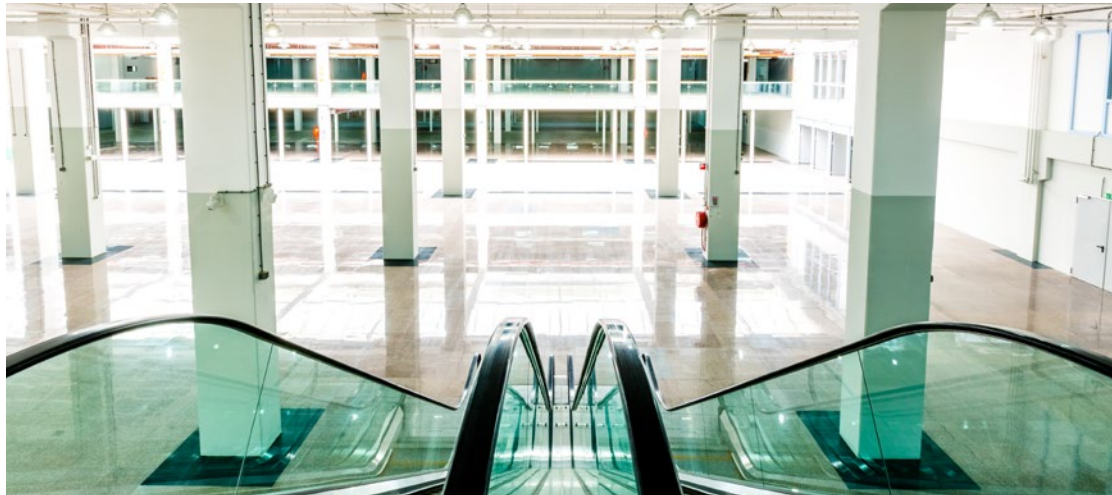
The reception building of GIA Trade & Exhibition Centre is spacious and has two cloakrooms and one service desk. The large Opal hall 1 that measures approximately 6,000 m² can be found on the ground floor. The Opal hall 2 measures approximately 2,000 m² and can be found on the first floor. This exhibition hall can be reached by a lift or staircase. The Onyx room on the ground floor and the Pearl room on the first floor are two smaller rooms that measure 650 m² and 1.000 m². They can, for example, be set up as break-out rooms, but are also ideal for organising a company party, a small meeting or to give a presentation. In total, GIA Trade & Exhibition Centre offers space to approximately 5,000 visitors.

Facilities

The event location has state-of-the-art facilities. Do you want additional registration desks, information desks and checkouts? You can. You can even install an ATM machine at trade fairs. All halls and rooms are accessible for wheelchair users and there are two large sanitary rooms, several smaller toilet blocks and two toilets for disabled guests. There is sufficient back stage space for catering or setting up technology and different rooms can be used as a production office or as a changing room during your event. At the rear of the building you will find a large, easily accessible loading area for the supply and removal of event material. The marble floors in the building ensure our premises are stylish and chic.

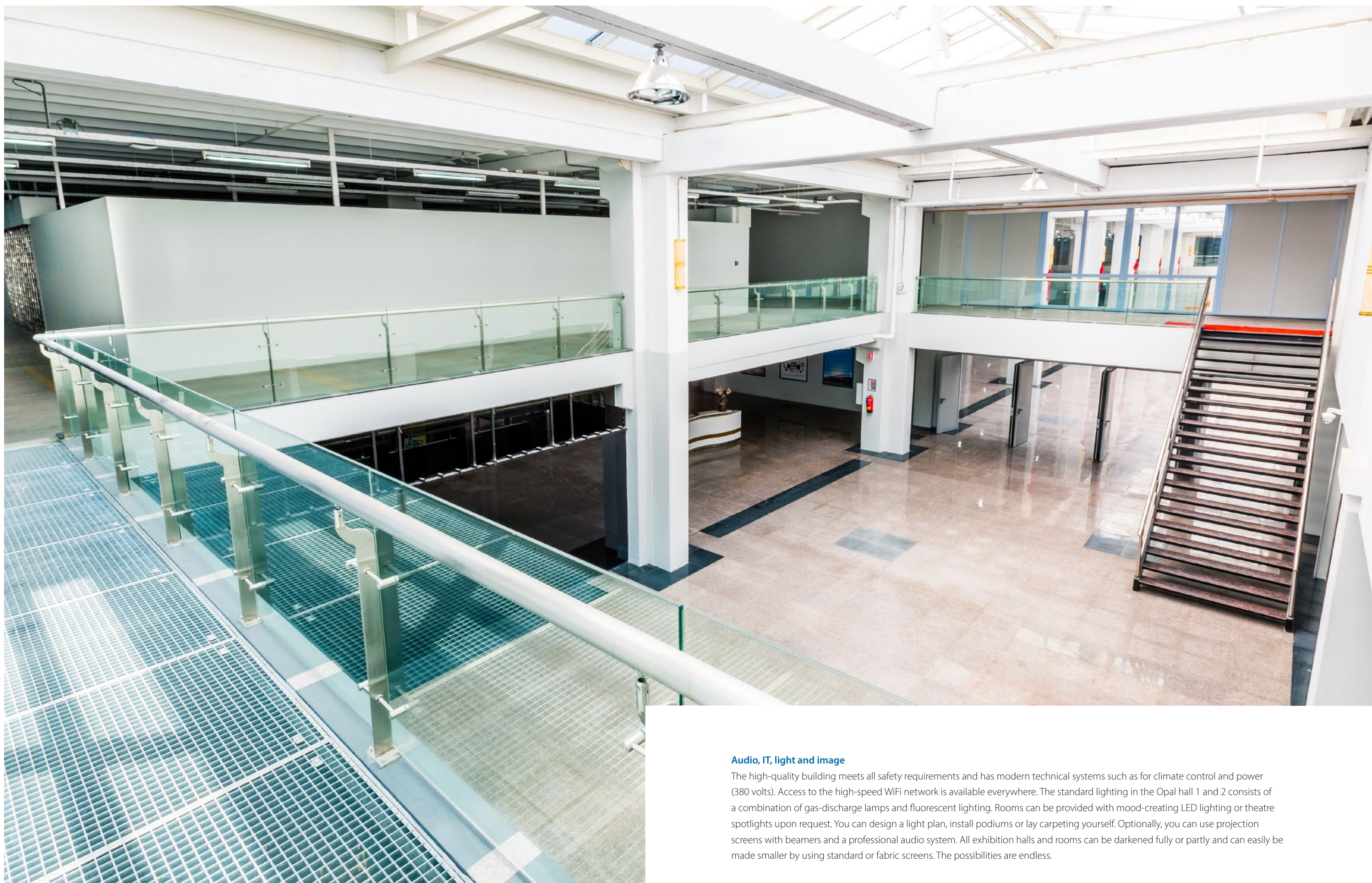




Professional partners

Audio, IT, light and image

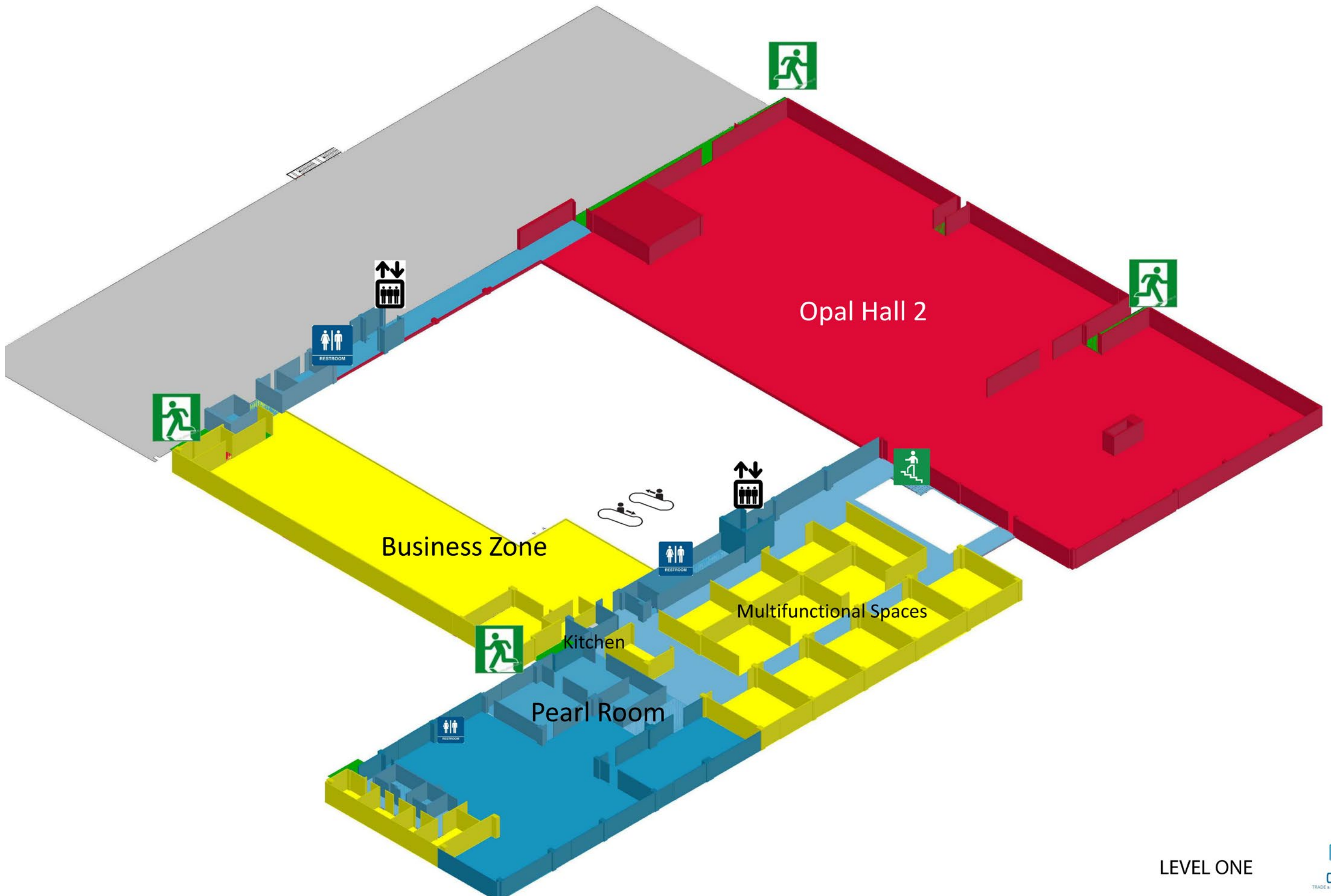
The high-quality building meets all safety requirements and has modern technical systems such as for climate control and power (380 volts). Access to the high-speed WiFi network is available everywhere. The standard lighting in the Opal hall 1 and 2 consists of a combination of gas-discharge lamps and fluorescent lighting. Rooms can be provided with mood-creating LED lighting or theatre spotlights upon request. You can design a light plan, install podiums or lay carpeting yourself. Optionally, you can use projection screens with beamers and a professional audio system. All exhibition halls and rooms can be darkened fully or partly and can easily be made smaller by using standard or fabric screens. The possibilities are endless.



Accessibility and parking

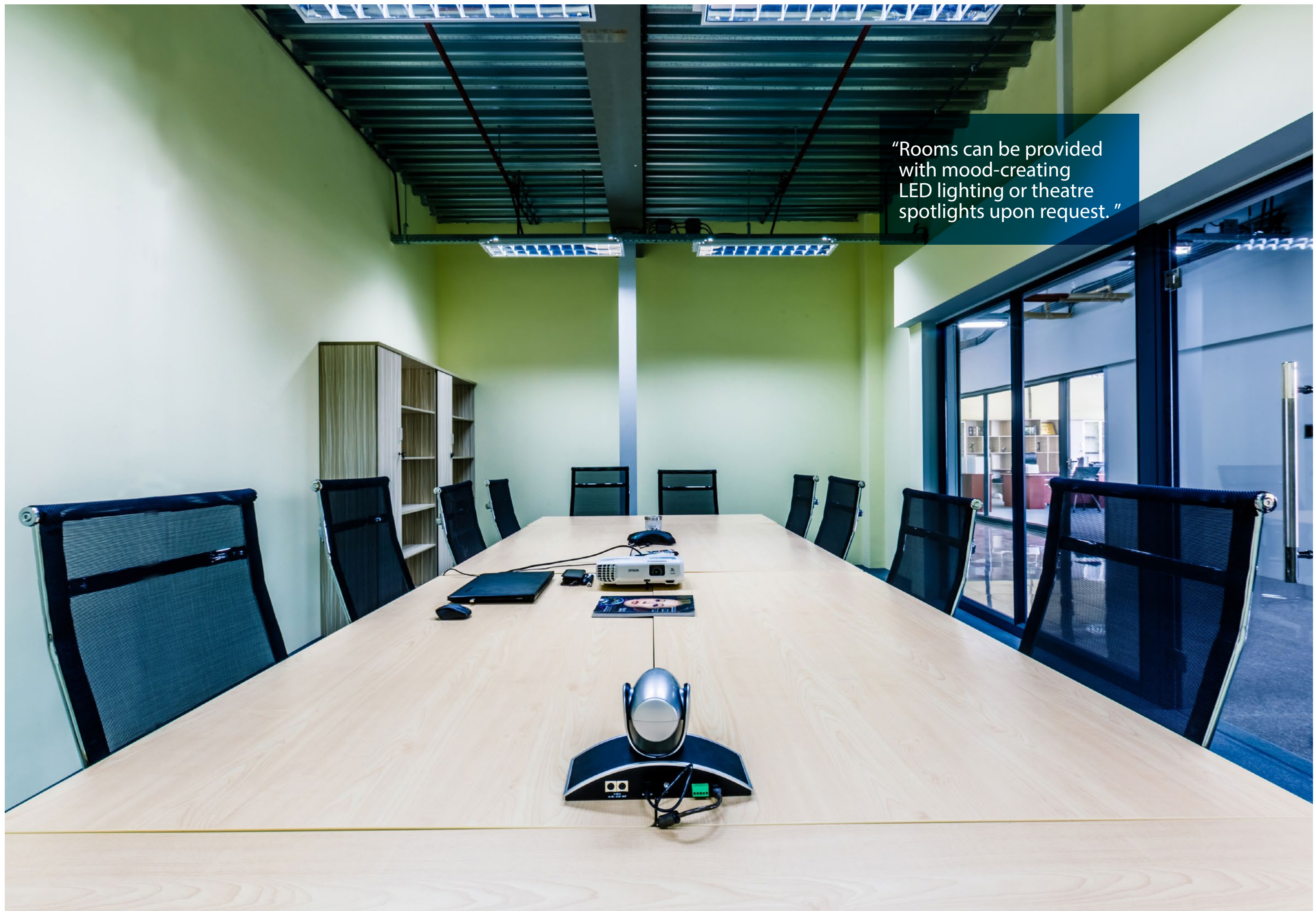
GIA Trade & Exhibition Centre can be easily reached by public transport. Tram 4 in the direction of De Uithof basically stops at the front door. Get off at the Beresteinlaan/Meppelweg tram stop and walk past the ROC Mondriaan School to the entrance of the event building. Do you want to visit with your car? The event building has its own 160 car park spaces. There is free parking everywhere in the area or you can park at De Uithof in The Hague. Shuttle buses can be used upon request.
