The World Forum

The Louwman Museum

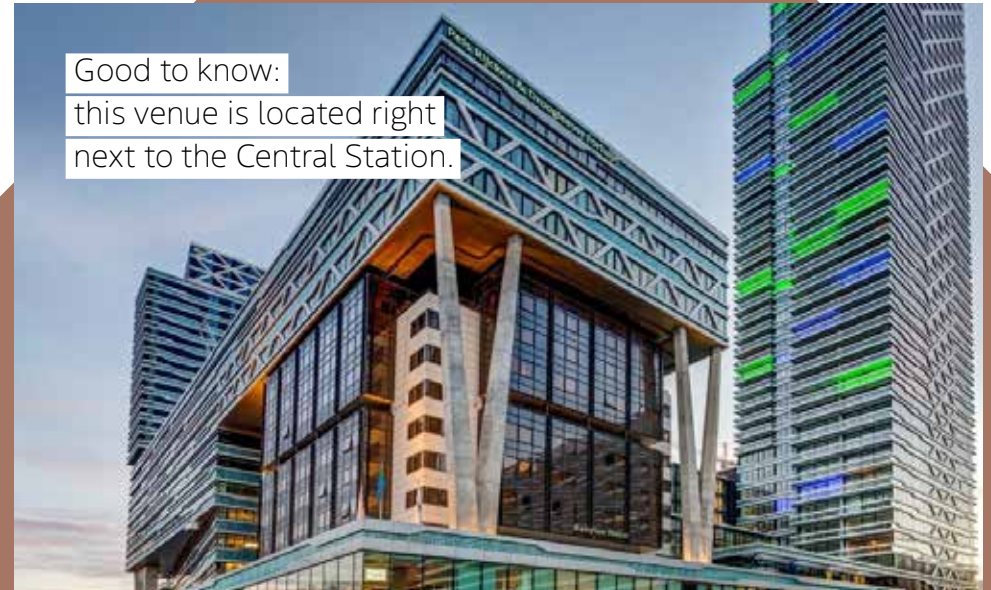
The Great Church

next to the Central Station.

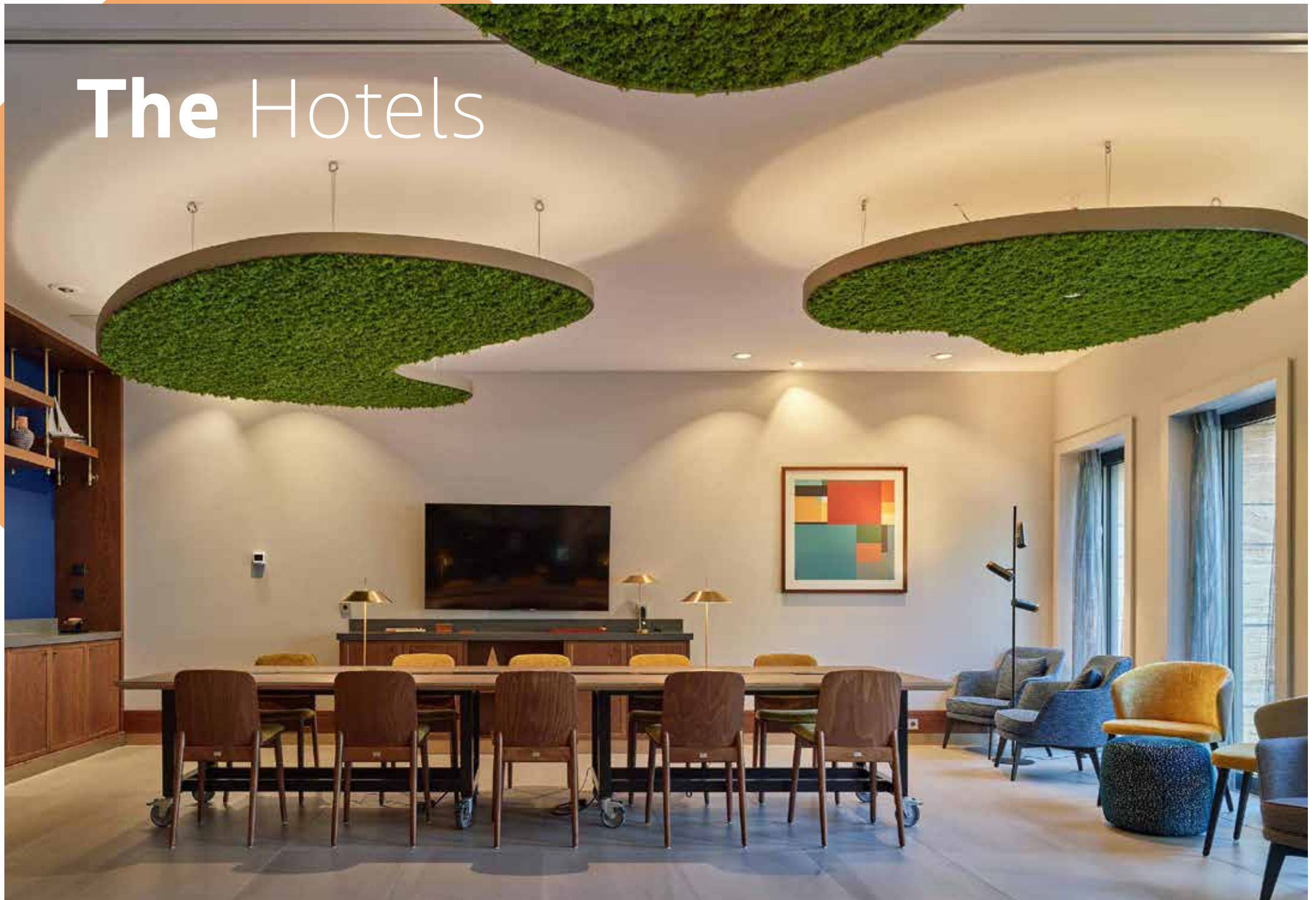

The Panorama

Panorama Mesdag offers a 360 degree vista of the sea, the dunes and the fishing village of Scheveningen as it was in 1881. This venue can host a maximum of 150 persons including 10 meeting rooms.



The Mauritshuis

Our intimate, world-class museum is located in the heart of historical and political The Hague. The Mauritshuis not only houses a world-famous collection of 17th century art, but is also an inspiring work location.

At the Mauritshuis, they understand the art of togetherness. That's why they make their attractive rooms available for meetings, training courses, lectures, receptions and presentations. You are guaranteed to be inspired when surrounded by the very best paintings of our Dutch and Flemish masters.

The monumental city palace is located in the most beautiful area of The Hague, right in the historical centre, adjacent to the Binnenhof. 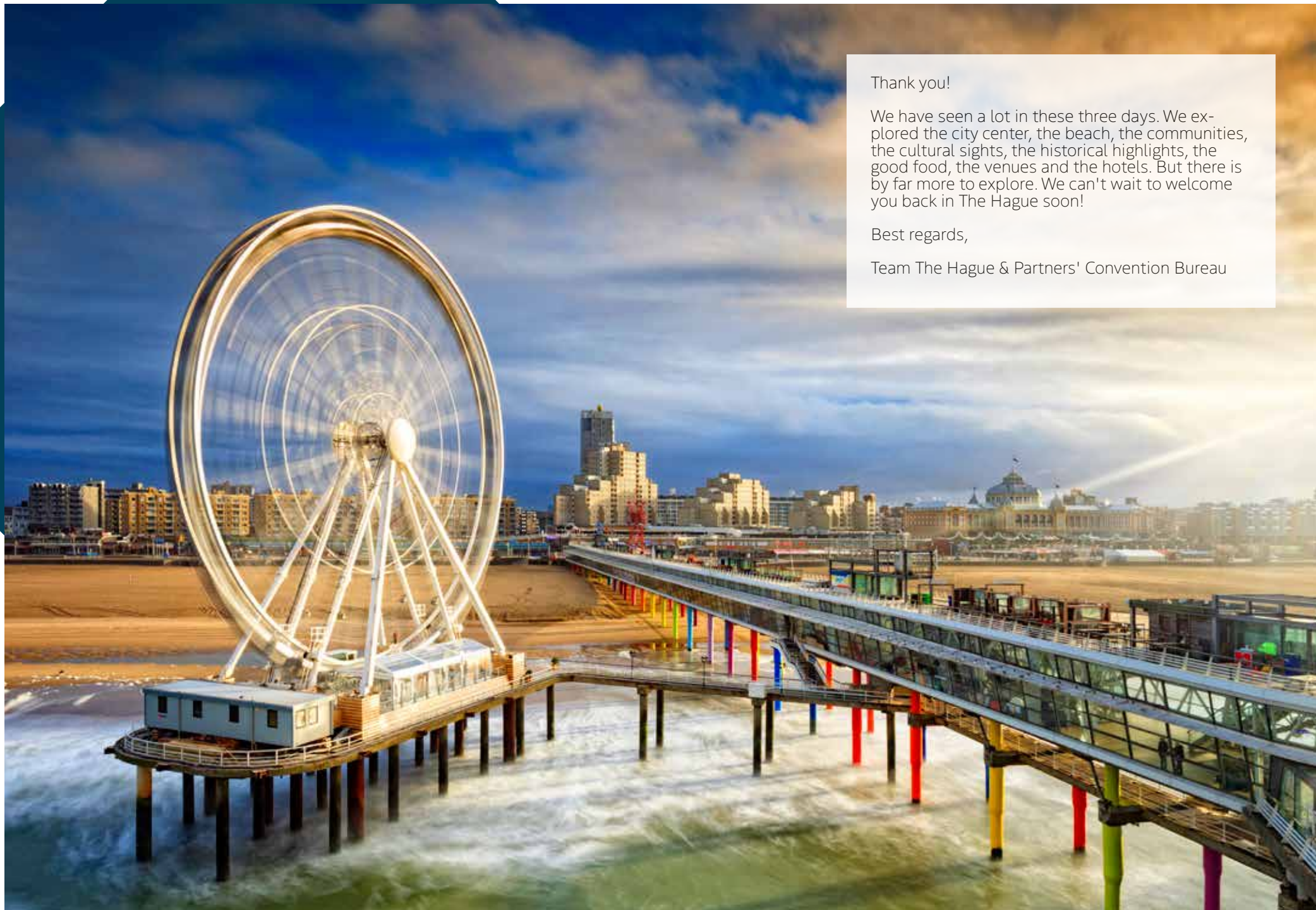
